

Criminal background checks vice. Some schools will incur are required for volunteers who may be in supervisory positions with students. The conviction of a crime (felony or misdemeanor) will not automatically disqualify a person from volunteering in a school. Each situation will be considered individually. Completed forms are maintained in a confidential manner at the district office. The district requires criminal checks on any volunteers (including parents) who meet the following criteria:

- the volunteer will have unsupervised contact with students:
- the volunteer has a regular and ongoing assignment at the school;
- the volunteer will be off campus with students in an unsupervised situation, including
- driving students on field trips; • the volunteer is a mentor
- to a student or students; • the volunteer is a coach
- or activity director; or • the volunteer is unknown
- to the school or department staff. Criminal background checks are administered through the

Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) at the Estill County Board of Education, room 108. AOC charges a \$10.00 processing fee for ser-
