Two first-degree burglaries reported on same day at different parts of county

The Estill County Sheriff's Department is investigating two burglaries. The burglaries have similarities but may not be related.

On Friday, July 12, Deputy Randy Farthing investigated a burglary at the residence of Patsy Barnes on Burton Williams Road, Irvine.

Farthing believes the intruder or intruders first broke out a side window of the home. He stated they could not gain entry due to the placement of a deep freezer.

A window was then broken out of the front door while allowed the intruders inside the residence.

A complete list of items taken and a dollar value of stolen items is pending.

A digital camera and three

weapons were reported missing. The weapons include a Ruger pistol, SKS, and a rifle.

A burglary was reported at the residence of Billy Wagers on Reges Road the same day. Items taken were valued at about \$370, but the list of stolen items may not be complete.

A 357 Remington magnum was stolen during the forced entry. The deputy said that intruder had pried open a back window to get inside.

Other items missing include jewelry, coins, a knife with a homemade handle.
