

# Estill Basketball Action Resumes

The basketball schedules for both the boys and girls Estill County High School teams have been altered by the severe weather conditions over the past few days but both squads may be able to get back into action with a boys game scheduled against Powell County away on Tuesday night and a re-scheduled game with Estill's girls taking on the Powell County Lady Pirates at home tonight, Wednesday, January 9th.

The Lady Engineers, coached by Mark McKinley, are 4-8 so far this year and are 0-1 in the 56th District, a loss to Lee County.

Tonight's opponent, Powell County, is one of the top teams in the 14th Region with a 10-5 record, including being 2-0 in the district.

The Lady Pirates are 6-1 in the region with a single loss to Leslie County while Breathitt County (8-1) is 8-0 in the region and their only loss was out of the region to Johnson Central.

The Lady Engineers' four wins have come against Model, Berea, Prestonsburg and Hart County.

Estill won over Model, 65-53, in the early season;

then came from behind to beat Berea in an overtime thriller, 66-63.

They also beat Prestonsburg, 52-49; then won a single game in the 4-game Taylor County Classic, 67-55 over Hart County.

Estill standout Kennedy Flynn scored 42 points in the win over Hart County. She also scored 39 in a loss to Pulaski County at Taylor County.

Following tonight's game against Powell County, the Lady Engineers will be in a double-header on Friday night with the Engineers at Owsley County.

Estill's girls play again on Saturday against Morgan County at West Liberty and will be at home on Monday night against Madison Southern.

Estill's boys, coached by Jon Bentley, are 7-7 for the season including 2-0 in the district.

The Engineers beat Lee County at home, 69-48, and won over Owsley County 70-65 in the Berea Invitational.

Estill went in to the Berea Invitational 4-3 but went 2-2 with wins over Owsley and Harlan County (65-64).

Estill's Trevor Jenkins put in 19 in a 70-60 loss to Somerset. Trevor Jones added 12 and Kris Dennis put in 11.

Estill also played in the Red River Classic at Stanton but won only one game, 74-47 over Lynn Camp.

The Engineers were scheduled to play Powell County at Stanton last night, Tuesday.

The Pirates are 6-7 and, like Estill, are 2-0 in the district.

Estill will be in the double-header with the Lady Engineers on Friday night in Booneville and will take on Mercer County at home next Tuesday, January 14th.



Welcome to Birding!

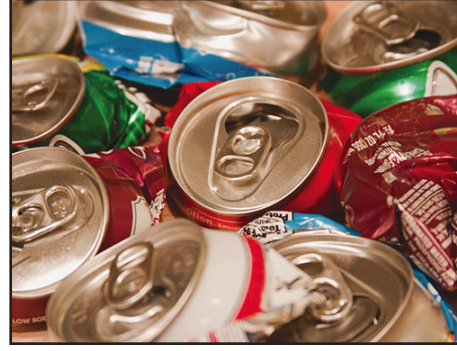
