Redneck Fruitcake

1 cup butter 1 teaspoon baking powder 1 teaspoon baking soda 1 cup sugar 1 cup dried fruit

1 cup brown sugar 4 large eggs 3 cups flour

1 teaspoon salt lemon juice

1 or 2 quarts whiskey
