

# 56<sup>th</sup> District Tournament Opens Monday In Booneville

Despite the crazy weather with record-setting snowfalls and cold temperatures, the 56th District Basketball Tournament is still expected to be held at Owsley County High School in Booneville, the week of February 23-27, 2015. Estill teams likely will not play again before

the tournament as weather forecasts predict future cancellations.

The tournament will begin on Monday night, February 27th with a girls double header.

The top district seed, Powell County Lady Pirates (5-1 & 14-10) open up

against 4th seed Lee County Lady Bobcats (1-5 & 10-16) at 6:00 p.m.

Estill's girls (13-12), the district's second seed, by virtue of wins over Owsley, will play the Owsley County Lady Owls (14-10) in the second game at 7:30 p.m. Both teams finished 3-3 in

the district.

All cheerleaders will be judged on this night only for the In-Game Competition. Estill's cheerleaders, who finished 4th in the state, are expected to do well but face some stiff competition from the other district squads.

Estill's boys will play on

Tuesday, and the other boys game will be on Wednesday, both starting at 7 p.m.

The regular season winner Estill County Engineers (6-0 & 16-9) are top seed and will take on 4th seed Lee County (0-6 & 1-25) on Tuesday.

Second seeded Powell

County (4-2 & 12-15) will play third seeded Owsley County (2-4 & 8-16) on Wednesday at 7:00 p.m.

The girls finals are on Thursday at 7:00 p.m., and the boys finals are on Friday at 7:00 p.m.
