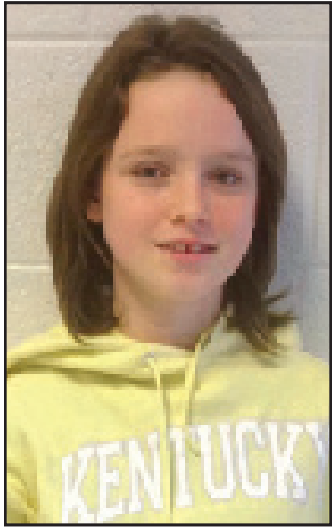


ECMS "Student Of The Week"
