Lindon said a request was denied last year because it asked to have decals for the Mushroom Festival on it, but he said there are now plans to paint the bridge.

The bridge was painted in the summer of 1998 before the bypass was opened and created traffic jams. Judge Wallace Taylor had also written the highway department asking for the one lane bridge on Millers Creek to be replaced.

"If you replace it, you've got a one lane tunnel entrance," Lindon said.

Lindon said this may cause the tunnel to be closed,

and motorist will travel Kirkland Avenue.

Magistrate Gerald Rader said big vehicles have to go that way, anyway.

Lindon said other roads will be resurfaced with monies coming from other funds. Roads on the list include the Bypass, Coal Wash Road, KY 52 from 1571 to the Pitts junction, and KY 89, two miles from the Jackson County line.

Lindon said some counties are out of salt. Those counties and cities which are completely out can purchase 25 tons of salt from the state transportation cabinet.
