The Estill County Engineers successful season continues as they were crowned 56th District Champions last week. A heart - stopping, hard fought victory against rival Powell County would bring the District Champion trophy back to Irvine for the second time in three years.

Estill would cruise to victory in their first round game against the Bobcats from Lee County, 64 - 34, as plenty of Engineers would score in this one.


