If outside, go to a safe shel- during a thunderstorm. ter immediately, such as inside a sturdy building. A hard top automobile with the windows up can also offer fair protection.

If you are boating or swimming, as a basement. get out of the water immediately and move to a safe shelter away available, move to a small interifrom the water!

If you are in a wooded area, seek shelter under a thick growth of relatively small trees.

If you feel you hair standing outdoors. on end, squat with your head between your knees. Do not lie flat!

Avoid: Isolated trees or other tall objects, bodies of water, sheds, tractors, and motorcycles.
