## Estill And Madison Counties Are Approved for the Emergency Conservation Program (ECP) for Flooding

USDA Kentucky Farm Service Agency (FSA) State Executive Director John W. McCauley has announced Agricultural producers in Estill and Madison Counties who suffered damage as a result of the April 2015 flooding may request cost-share assistance from USDA to rehabilitate damaged farmlands. The Emergency Conservation Program for Flooding (ECP), administered by the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture, Farm Service Agency (FSA), provides cost-share assistance when disaster damage is so severe that recovery without federal assistance is unlikely.

ECP practices that may be applicable to flooding would be assistance for debris removal, fence restoration, grading, shaping and re-leveling and restoring conservation structures and other installations. The land must be agricultural land and the damage

must be impeding the production of the land and must be of such magnitude that recovery without federal assistance is unlikely. Conservation problems existing prior to the disaster are ineligible for ECP assistance.

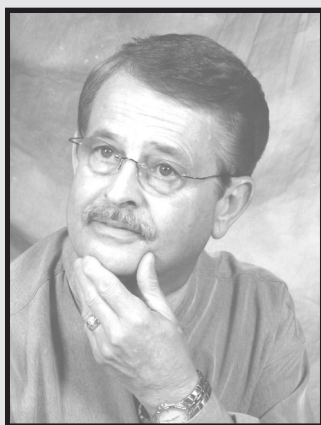
Producers may request assistance through their local office beginning May 8, 2015 through June 7, 2015. When a request for assistance is filed, it is important that the applicant know the extent of damage and the action that is going to be required to recover from the damages. The water may need to rescind before the applicant will be able to complete an accurate application for assistance. An onsite inspection by FSA is required.

For addition information producers should contact their local FSA Service Center.
