5. All sheep must have a Scrapie Tag as required by KDA
6. There will be a $\$ 5$ gate fee.
7. All 4 -Hers must complete the 6 hour livestock education and show proof.
Premiums: 1st Place-\$10; 2nd Place-\$7; 3rd Place-\$5 (for all classes except Champion \& Novice Showmanship)
A Susan B. Anthony coin dollar will be given to each participant in Novice Showmanship
Jr. and Sr. Showmanship: 1st Place - \$10, 2nd Place - \$7 nd 3rd Place $\$ 5$
