

# 2018 ESTILL COUNTY FAIR RULES

## Admission Prices:

**Saturday, June 30 – Beauty Pageants and Swine Show – \$8.00 for ages 3 and up**

(Pay at the gate for the swine show; pay at the Exhibit Hall front door next to the parking

**Saturday, June 30 – lot for each pageant) – Concert – \$15 for ages 3 and up**

**Monday, July 2 – No fair board activities or carnival this night. Only the Poultry Show will take place on this night.**

**Tuesday, July 3 and Wednesday, July 4 – \$10.00 for ages 3 and up. \*\*Ages 2 and under get in free.**

**Thursday, July 5 – Saturday, July 7 – \$12.00 for ages 3 and up. \*\*Ages 2 and under get in free.**

**\*\*If age 2 and under want to ride, you will have to pay full admission price.**

**One price pays all - admission, parking, fair activities and Paradise Amusement Rides**

1. All Family & Consumer Sciences exhibits this year must not have been exhibited in an Estill County Fair before. Exhibits must be original work of the exhibitor.

2. All exhibits of 4-H, FHA or FFA members must be part of this year's work and can only be entered by 4-H, FHA or FFA members and enrollment must be according to attendance produced in conjunction with an approved project sponsored by these organizations.

3. All exhibits must be produced in Estill County except open shows which are open to all Kentucky exhibitors or as indicated in the specific activity section.

4. In case of only one exhibit to a class, the quality of the exhibit will be awarded prize or ribbon it deserves according to the placing of the judges.

5. All crops must be grown in 2018.

6. Only persons living in Estill County will be eligible to exhibit in Horse and Livestock Shows, and Dog Shows except for open shows or as stated in the specific activity section.

7. All livestock must be halter broken, halter furnished by owner, except swine and un-halterd cattle shown in truck.

8. All exhibits other than livestock and perishables must remain on display until 9:30 A.M. Saturday. These exhibits must be checked out, with stubs that was received when entering. Exhibit stubs must be presented to person checking out exhibits.

9. The management will take all precautions possible, but will not be responsible for accidents or loss incurred while exhibiting at the fair.

10. Committee in charge of each department will take entries in that department and see that someone is in charge of entries at all times. The committee will check out entries, collecting stubs as the entries are taken out.

11. Only one entry allowed. This rule applies to ALL entries.

12. Qualified judges will be secured.

13. Prizes will be on schedule as announced at fair time; except 4-H, FHA and FFA which will be judged on the Danish System. The premium will be divided among participants in each class to help make prize money more equal for large classes and small classes. In case of a small number of entries, the prize will not be excessive. Ribbons will have a value for computing the prize - Blue 3X, Red 2X, and White 1X. They will be notified during the week of the fair when and where to pick up their money.

14. The Estill County Fair Board reserves the right to adjust prize premiums, if necessary.

15. The Estill County Fair Board and Estill County Extension Service will not be responsible for typographical errors.

Prize money for any one exhibit in 4-H, FHA and FFA shall not exceed the amount paid for the result in open class exhibits of similar type.

The Estill County Fair Board will have an attending veterinarian on the grounds at all Horse Shows held during the fair. The Estill County Fair Board is cooperating in the enforcement of the Horse Protection Act.

The Estill County Fair is planned and conducted according to rules and regulations of the Kentucky Department of Agriculture for the use of state funds. All 4-H, FHA and FFA items will be judged on the Danish System. This will assure each exhibitor a ribbon and prize money. Each blue, red and white ribbon will be worth so much prize money, and every qualified item will be awarded a ribbon. These exhibitors will be notified when to come and pick up their money.

## Livestock Health Requirements

All livestock/animals offered for sale or exhibition at Kentucky County Fairs shall meet the following regulations according to KRS Chapter 257:

a. 302 KAR 20:040 (Entry into Kentucky)

b. 302 KAR 20:065 (Sale and Exhibition of Kentucky Origin Livestock)
