A. Sow & Litter and Pen of 5 Feeder Pigs to be shown in truck or trailer, separated into class groups. Same animal(s) not eligible in more than one class of youth division.

B. All 4-H exhibitors must have completed the 6 hours of livestock education and show proof.

C. Market hogs will be shown off the trailer.

1. Sow & litter. Pigs one (1) to six (6) weeks old. Sow must be owned by the exhibitor at least 30 days before farrowing. Judging on number of pigs, health, thriftiness and size for age of pigs.

2. Pen of 5 feeder pigs. Five (5) to ten (10) weeks of age. The sow(s) must be owned by exhibitor at least 30 days before farrowing.

MARKET DIVISION - Must be owned by exhibitor a minimum of 60 days
