Rules: (Gate Fee: \$5.00)

1. Committee may combine classes or breeds if there are less than 2 exhibitors exhibiting less than 3 animals.
2. Sheep must meet Kentucky Health Requirements.
3. Market lambs must have less than 1/4" fleece.
4. Sheep must be clean, fitted, or sheared for showing.
5. All sheep must have up-to-date health papers.
6. All sheep must have a Scrapie Tag as required by KDA.
7. There will be a \$5 gate fee.
8. All 4-Hers must complete the 6 hour livestock education and show proof.

Premiums: 1st Place-\$10; 2nd Place-\$7; 3rd Place-\$5 (for all classes except Champion & Novice Showmanship)

A Susan B. Anthony coin dollar will be given to each participant in Novice Showmanship.

Jr. and Sr. Showmanship: 1st Place - \$20

Premiums may increase until show day pending additional sponsors.
