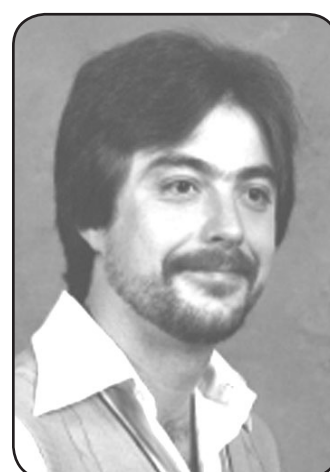

Douglas Edward Shean, age 55, of Irvine, Kentucky, passed away on Tuesday, September 29, 2020, after a long illness.

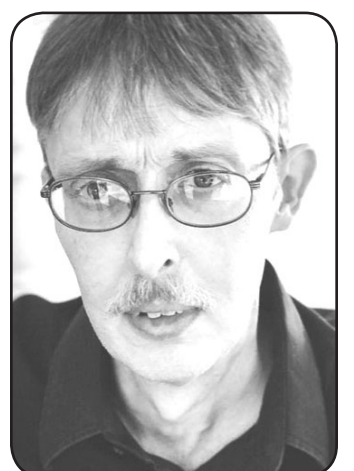
