The Engineers avenged an earlier loss to the Wolfe County Wolves by winning 69-56 at home last Tuesday night. Sophomore Landon Napier and Joe

Benton led them to a win to the delight of the home crowd with 25 and 20 points respectively. Benton continues to rebound as well as score and pulled down 11.

Estill then traveled to Buckhorn for the Scott Blank Classic where they were upset 71-59 despite 22 and 20 performances by Napier and Benton. Benton also hauled down 11 rebounds.




