In **Psalms 9:17**, it is written, "The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God." The original language is very emphatic, "headlong into hell."

It seems today that men, as a majority, are not choosing to live in a fear of God. Even today, there are many nations and individuals who claim to know God yet seem to be forgetful of him. They choose not to remain always mindful of him and do not acknowledge him in their actions. They, says this verse, are to be thrust away down into hell. So, just how many are there who are forgetful, unholy, unthankful -- who care not for him who died for them on the cross?
