The little boy looks at him happily and says, "Just keep pulling on that string. It'll come back to ya!"

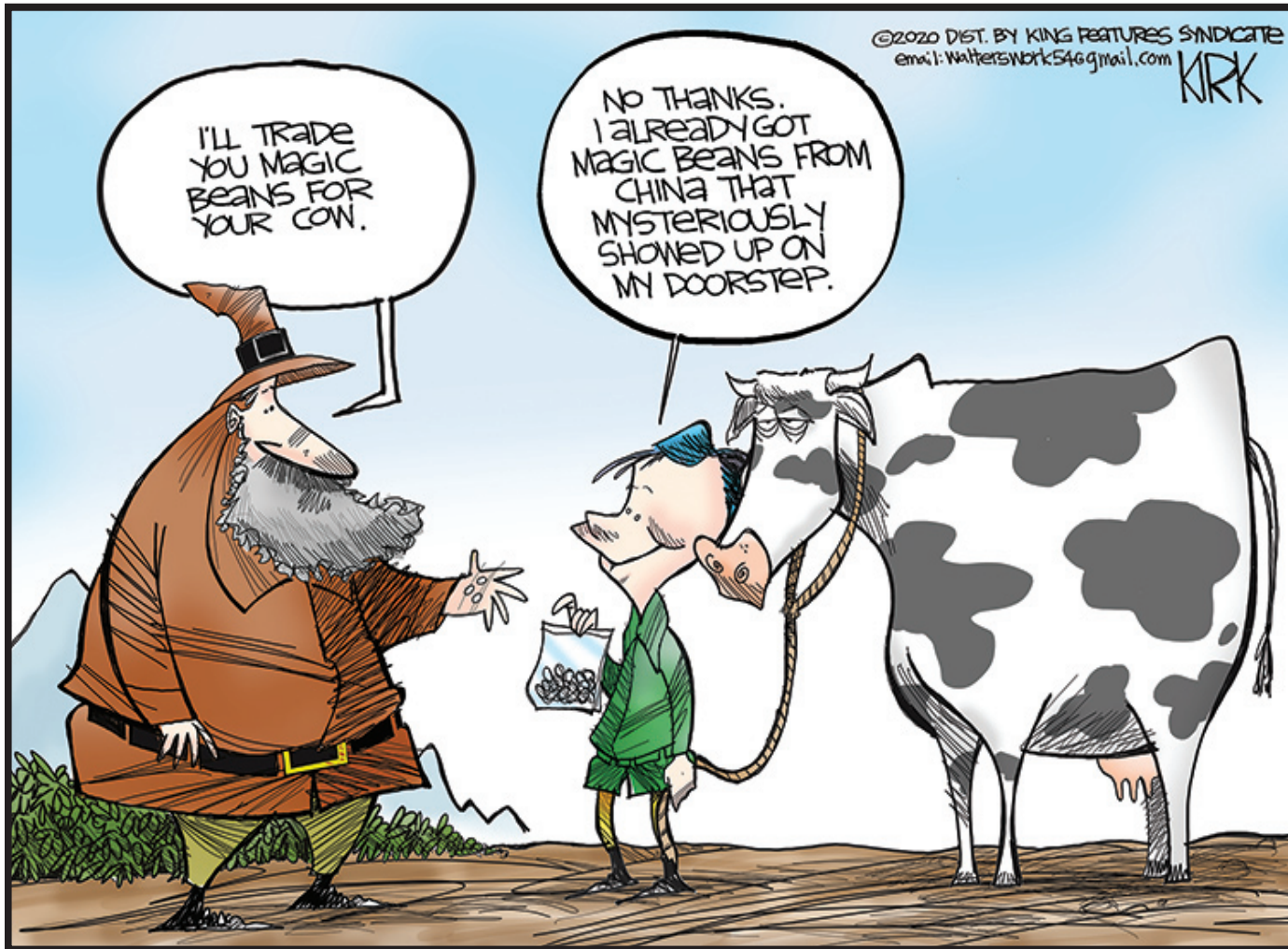
## Back to School
