Spring 2020 Eastern Graduates

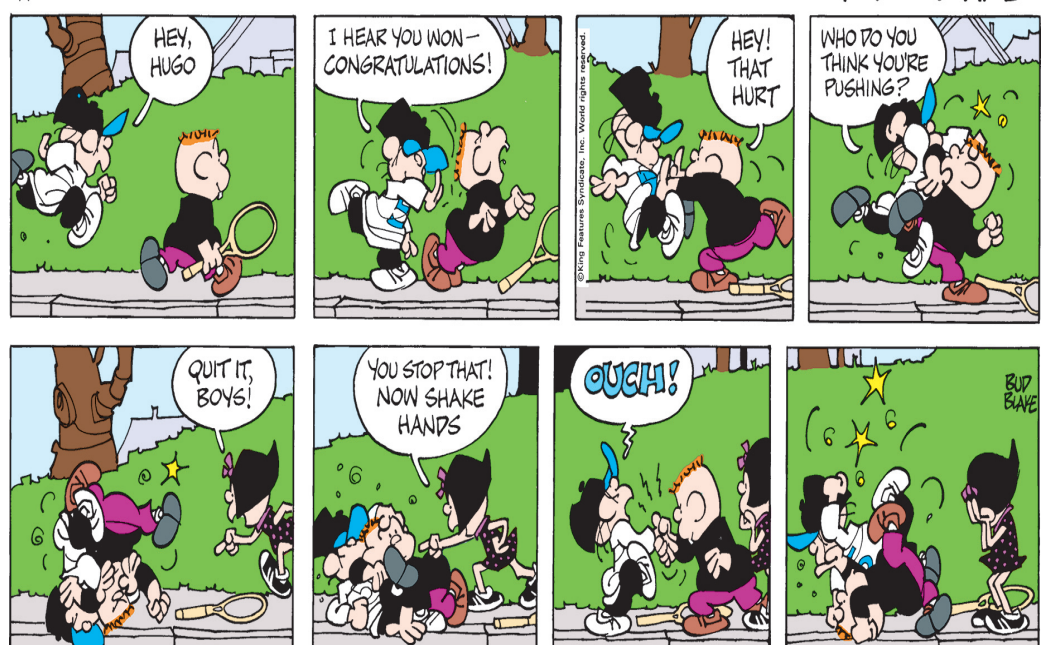
