Norman F. Christopher, 89

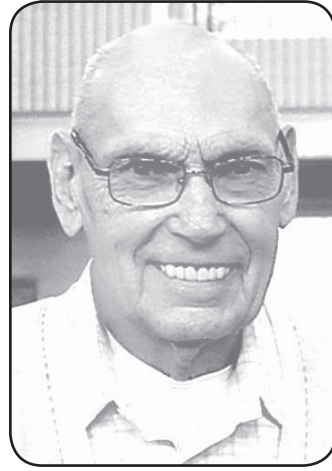
