You can now make your own pumpkin spice mix that can be used to bake everything from ³/₄ cup buttermilk, chilled Bundt Cakes to biscuits. Pumpkin Spice Biscuits and Pumpkin Spice Butter would be delicious on cool fall mornings.

Homemade Pumpkin Spice Yield: approximately ¹/₄ cup

3 Tbsp. ground cinnamon 1 Tablespoon ground nutmeg 1 Tablespoon ginger

2 Teaspoons ground allspice In small bowl, stir together all

ingredients until combined. Store in an airtight container up to 1 year.

 $\frac{3}{4}$ cup cold unsalted butter, cubed

2 Tbsp. unsalted butter, melted. Preheat oven to 425 degrees.

Line baking sheet with parchment paper. Set aside.

In a large bowl, stir together flour, sugar and, Homemade Spice Mix. Using a fork, cut butter into flour until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Add buttermilk stirring until combined.

Turn dough on well-floured surface. Knead several times. Pat into 10x9 inch rectangle. Use a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch round cutter, dipped in flour, cut dough without twisting cutter. Place in rounds prepared pan, spacing two inches apart. Brush tops with melted butter. Chill in refrigerator for approximately 10 minutes. Bake until golden brown approximately 12 minutes. Service with Pumpkin Spice Butter.

PLEASE NOTE:

The 2020 County tax bills are due and payable at the Estill County Sheriff's office as of October 1, 2020. The following are collection dates:

October 1, 2020 – November 1, 2020
November 2, 2020 – December 31, 2020
January 1, 2021 – January 31, 2021
February 1, 2021 – April 15, 2021 (close of business)

The Estill County Sheriff's office will transfer the delinquent property tax bills to the county clerk as of the close of business on April 15th.

IMPORTANT:

- Anyone who would like to pay his or her tax bill via phone (debit card or credit card) should contact the Estill County Sheriff's Office at (606) 723-2323.
- Anyone who has not received his or her tax bill should contact the Estill County Sheriff's Office.
- Anyone whose taxes are paid through an escrow account is responsible for forwarding the tax bills to their mortgage company.
