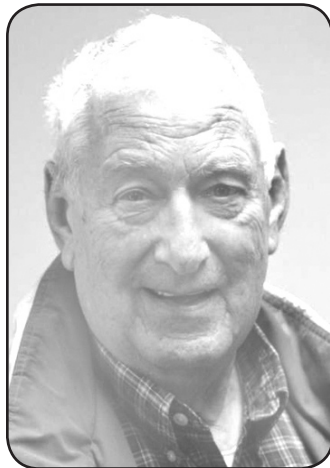
Harry Clevenger, 85
