

Engineers 1-1 after 40-6 win over Lynn Camp Wildcats

The Estill County Engineers got started early on Friday night at Hoover Niece Field and went on to win 40-6 over the Wildcats from Lynn Camp.

The big win evened Estill's record at 1-1 before their season was put on a stand-still by the Corona virus. Estill's next game is cancelled and the Engineers must wait until conditions improve for hopes of another game.

For that reason, Estill's senior night was moved up to early in the season and seven seniors and their parents were honored before the game.

Seniors include Logan Riddell, Dustin Beeler, Coben Clem, Trevyn Niece, Dyllon Long, Chris Fields, and Carson O'Bryan.

Coben Clem is a third generation player for the Estill seniors in its 50-year history. His grandfather, Lonnie Clem was one of the original players for the Estill Engineers in 1970-71 when they played their first season of football.

"I was really pleased with the effort our kids gave Friday night," said head coach Jordan Marcum. "I feel like we gained some momentum from the end of the Breathitt game and it carried over."

Junior quarterback Ty Niece got 222 yards rushing and scored three touchdowns with a total of 20 points. Estill had 414 yards total rushing with 90 from Jonothon Short, 48 from Caden Arvin, 34 from Clem (12 points), and Braden Waddle with 26.

Ty Niece had 69 yards passing and Caleb Witt had 14 for 83 total passing yards for Estill.

Jarrett Spivey, Knott, and Arvin had six tackles each on defense and Waddle and Ty Niece had 5 each.

Marcum said, "defensively we played much better and got some things adjusted and that made us better."

He added, "offensively we continue to look sharper and got better on special teams. However we had a lot of penalties and have to clean that before we get a chance to play again."

All Estill County sports is cancelled this week including the Engineers' game with Rockcastle County on Friday night.

The Rockets game was the last home game on Estill's schedule until the Powell County game on November 6th with three away games between.

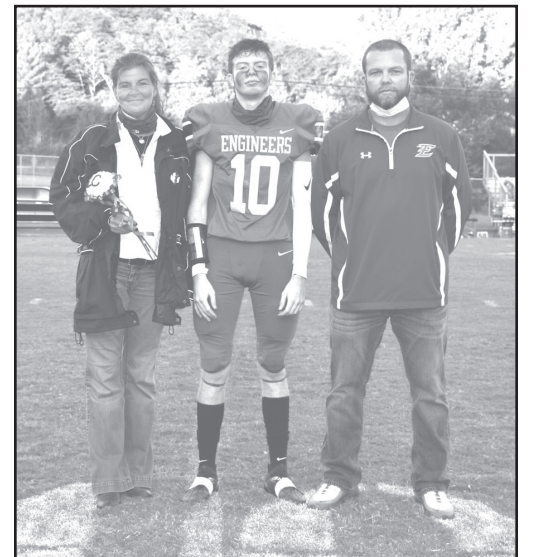

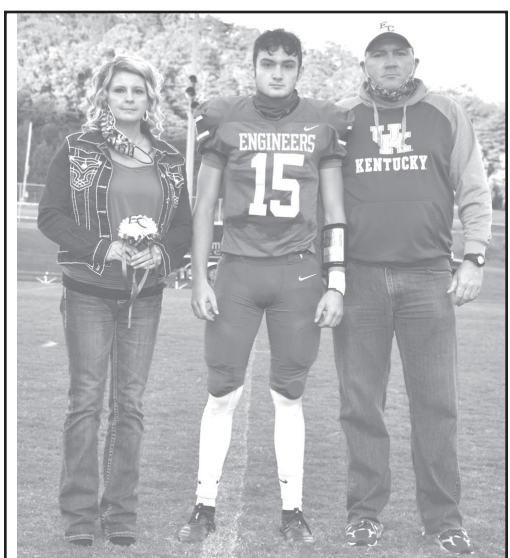

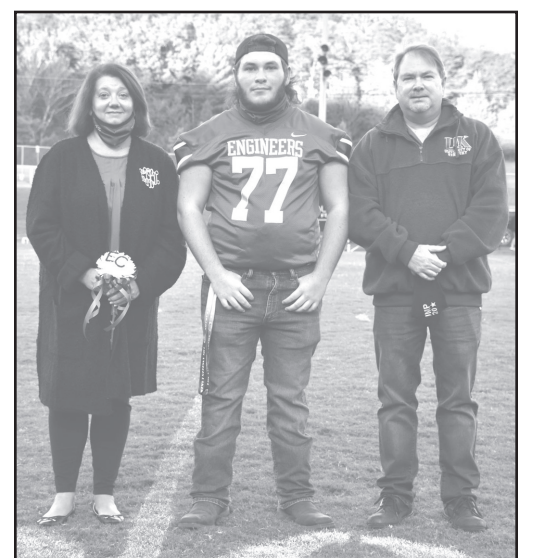
