George Lewis Bowling, 78

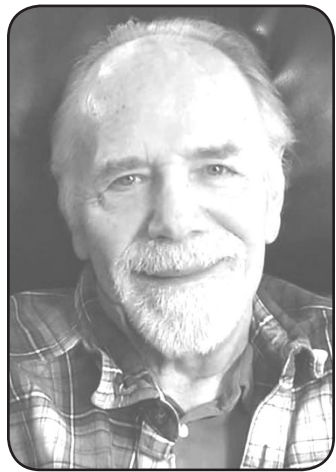

Lena G. Wilson, 94

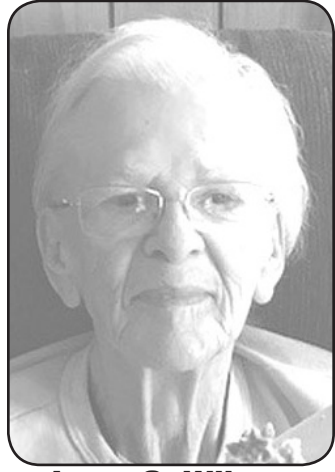
