Musical performers will include Buck Winburn and Mountain Rain, Charlie Conkright and Hard Drive, Maddie Murray, String Theory, The Goodwin Brothers,

and the Spencer Boys.

It is time for us to start getting back to a sense of normality, and I cannot think of a better way to do that than coming together to do something great for our kids," said State Senator Brandon Storm.
