On May 11, 2020, KSP Irvine Police Chief John Sturniolo, and Irvine Ofto Powell's apartment to serve an arrest warrant which had been obtained by the Irvine Police Department for an incident the preceding day.

That warrant charged Powell with first degree stalking. According to Irvine Detective Sam Hensley, Powell threatened a to the City of Irvine, and female while holding a handgun.

A second indictment Powell on June 16, 2020 for the alleged stalking.


