Memorial Day 2021 Stone Coal Memorial Service Canceled

The board of directors of Stone Coal Cemetery, located on Farmers Ridge (KY 587) in Lee County, has decided to cancel this year's annual memorial service due to lingering concerns over COVID-19. The service is held annually the Sunday of Memorial Day weekend and was also not held last year because of the virus.

Family members are encouraged to pay their respects to loved ones buried in the cemetery individually again this year, with hopes that the service can be held as normal in 2022.

The cemetery relies totally on individual contributions from relatives of those interred for upkeep and maintenance. Since the cancellation of the service means that a collection cannot be taken at the cemetery, donations should be mailed to the cemetery's treasurer, Dorsey Creech, 211 Bradshaw Hills Road, McKee KY 40447.

Since we are in the COVID-19 pandemic, I thought you might be interested in what our process is for books that are being returned to us and how we get them ready to return to our shelves..

The first thing that happens is they are checked in and sanitized. Then they are checked out to one of our newest patrons by the name of "Quarantine Items". They are then taken to one of our meeting rooms and spaced out on tables and dated with the date that they are going into quarantine and the date they will come out, which is seven (7) days. When the seven days are up, they are checked in and placed on a cart, where from there they are ready for shelving.

As the number of Covid-19 cases rise and fall here in our county the zone color affects how you are able to use the li-

brary. When we are in the red zone the library will do curbside services and home delivery ONLY. We are still able to fax, copy, and notarize at the door or from your vehicle. You can also request books or movies by calling us, or from our website, and we will check the items out on your account and have them ready for you to pick up, or for home delivery. Our free public Wi Fi is available from our parking lot, 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week.

When we are in the Orange zone, the library will be allowing limited entry into the building. Limited access allows up to 10 people (including staff) to be in the library at one time for brief visits. You must wear your mask over your nose and mouth to enter. Neither our water fountains nor restrooms are available. We will also continue curbside service and home delivery if you wish to use that service.

Our director, Kathy Watson will be retiring the end of June; we would like to wish her a HAPPY RETIREMENT.
