It is written in Matthew 12:31-32, "Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall *be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the* Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. 32And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come."

<u>First of all</u>, what are the definitions of blasphemy? The <u>act of expressing evil</u>,; a <u>lack of reverence</u> toward God; a defilement, desecration, impurity, profane, and to address with irreverence.

To understand the seriousness of these two verses, one has to consider just who is this Holy Spirit? In 1 John 5:7-8, he is the third person in the Peter to write in **1 Peter 3:21**, these words, *"The* Godhead, and he is bearing witness in the earth today. How is he doing this? In John 16:13-14, Jesus said, "Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, *he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak* of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. 14He believe that which the Holy Spirit caused to be writshall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you." Jesus says in Verse 8, "And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment." 


