Beverly Wayne Barnes, 74

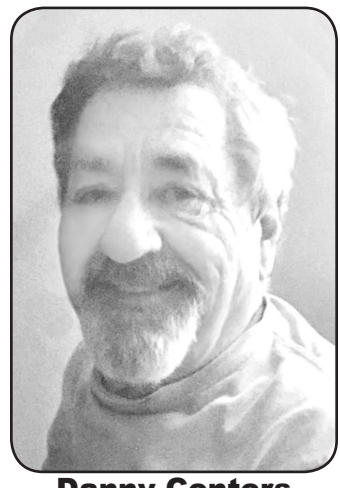

Otis Wayne Cox, 56

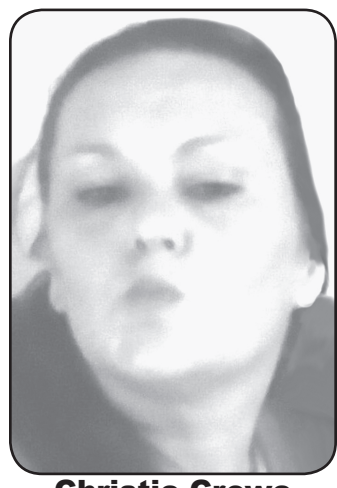
