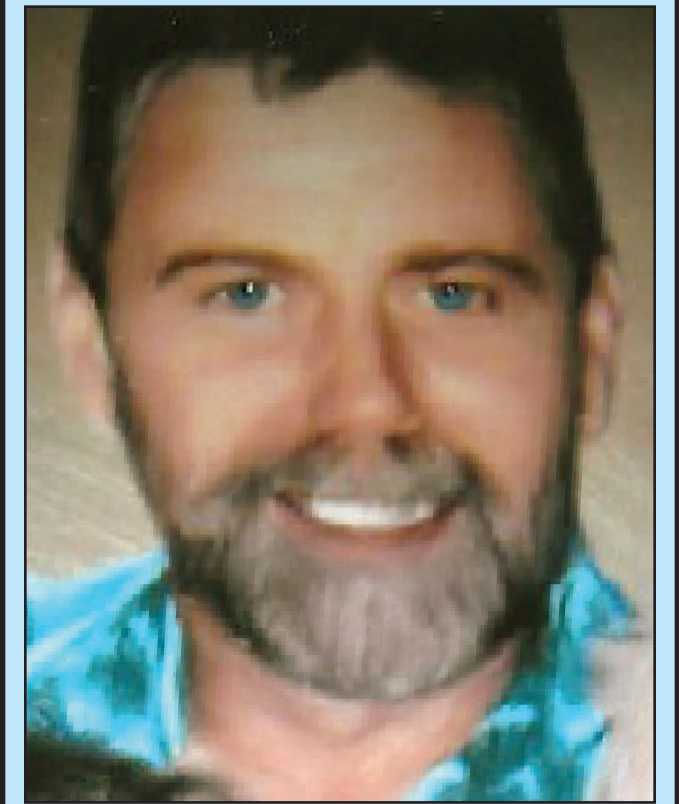




KENTUCKY'S 2021 BASS FISHING TEAMS

More than 300 of the country's best bass fishing teams converged on Chickamauga Lake in Tennessee for the 2021 Bassmaster High School National Championship, July 29-31. In addition to a national title, anglers hoped to reel in their share of a prize purse worth more than \$20,700 and \$600,000 in college scholarships. Two members of the Estill County Bass Fishing Team participated. Luke Fletcher and Hunter Flynn were sitting in 86th place in a 300-plus boat field after day one, 4 lbs. out of 12th place which makes the cut for Saturday.
