A False Hope

Matthew 7:21, "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? ^{23.} And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

It would seem that so many folks in our world have religion, and there are so many kinds to choose from. People argue about them, some fight in the name of their religion, killing and hating all those who are of a different belief. Yet, even among those who belong to a church that proclaims Jesus as Lord, there are those who feel "safe" because they have religion. 




