Has God Changed?

Today, when we listen to what man is saying, and coupling to this, the things that they are doing, and claiming to be religious while they are doing it, one would believe that God has changed.

In **Psalm 119:89**, "Forever, O Lord, that word is settled in Heaven." Then in **Malachi 3:6**, "For I am the Lord. I change not." And to add what our Lord says in **Matthew 24:35**, "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."

When we read verses such as these, and there are others, one when honest with themselves will plainly see that our Lord has not changed His mind concerning anything He has previously said.

Space will prevent me from exhausting all the things that could be said related to our Lord's commands, so I will touch upon a few of them.

Jesus says in **Matthew 16:13-18**, "Upon this rock I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." But now, look what men have done. 2,400 different groups all claiming to be Christ's church, all having different teachings. Can this be right? Did our Lord build more than one?

The plan that saves. Did our Lord give more than one. Consider **Acts 4:12**, "For there is none other name under Heaven, given among men whereby we must be saved." "Jesus says, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man cometh unto the father but by me." (**John 14:6**). Notice the singularity of these words.

So today, has our Lord changed His mind concerning church attendance? By the way men are living, one would think He has. But our Lord says in **Hebrews 10:25-29**, "Not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together." But still this is being ignored by a great many of religious claimants.

God's Law of Marriage. Has our Lord changed His mind? **1 Corinthians 6:2**, "Nevertheless to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband." But today, they are living together without considering our Lord's commands. Can this be nothing short of fornication? He says in **verse 9**, same chapter, that none will enter Heaven living in this manner.

Same sex marriages: This was never in God's plan. Has God changed His mind? Again, no place in heaven for these people. In **Romans 1:32**, God has not changed His mind about their end, saying, "They are worthy of death!"

Last. Has God changed His mind about death and the judgment? In **Hebrews 9:27**, "It is appointed unto man, once to die, and after this the judgment." By observing the actions of mankind, one might be led to the idea that neither one will come. They treat life like it is a joke. But eternity in a lake of fire is no joke. It will come upon all the unbelieving and disobedient world.

In **Revelation 20:11-15** here is a picture of Jesus sitting upon His throne of eternal judgment, and He will have all our records. So nothing will be forgotten, all will be revealed. Knowing this, what will your record reveal if it were to happen today? You will have made our choice.

Hebrews 13:8, "Jesus Christ, the same, yesterday, today, and forever." He changes not!
