Statebound Again Estill Marching Engineers Are Regional Champs

The Marching Engineers traveled back to Bourbon County Saturday for regional competition. All qualifying AA bands in the eastern part of the state gathered to determine which 8 would advance to state level competition next week in Louisville.

Estill had an early draw and were the 3rd band to perform. Knowing it was the most important performance of the year thus far, the band turned in a stellar performance! This was easily the best performance of the season and it could not have happened at a better time. Upon completion of the class AA performances, it was time for the results to be read. First, distinguished ratings were announced to those bands receiving a score of 80 or higher. Estill and Garrard were the only two bands in the region

earning this distinction.

When the scores were released, Estill edged out Garrard to take the 1st PLACE SPOT IN THE EAST REGION!!

This coming Friday, the band will travel to Louisville to compete in State competition. All AA regional finalist (the 8 bands from the East and 8 from the West) will compete on Saturday in state semifinals at the Christian Academy of Louisville. Estill will perform at 1:30.

Only four bands will advance from this 16 to earn a place in State Finals and perform that night at Papa John's Cardinal Stadium.
