One of the most talkedabout races coming up on the ballot for Harlan County on Election Day is the office of District Judge for the 26th Judicial District, a position left vacant by the passing of Harlan District Judge Jeff Brock on April 22. Judge Ralph E. McClanahan II has shouldered the bulk of the work in Harlan District Court since that time.

"Judge Brock was my friend," McClanahan said. "I think he graduated from (Salmon P.) Chase Law School about six months before I did."

McClanahan reported to work in the Harlan District Courtroom at the end of May and worked several days in June and July. He presided the full months of August, September and October, and he will continue in his current position until the new judge takes the bench.


