As you go through life and talk to many people be careful of what you listen to. There are many who are good speakers and can be very persuasive about their beliefs. The Lord, in <u>Matthew 24:4</u>, said, "Take heed that no man deceive you." There were, and are, false teachers who teach false doctrines. Some may mean well, but are still wrong, not fully understanding the scriptures. Then there are those who don't really care about the truth they just want to have people follow them. This is what Jesus referred to, when he said, "Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch." Matthew 15:14.
