Hebrews 11:24-26, "By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season; Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the

In this scripture we see that Moses made a choice as to how he would live his life. All of us are faced with the same basic choice. We can serve the world and live according to the flesh, or choose to live for the Lord. That is the only two choices that there are and, we will choose one or the other.

Moses had been raised in the palace as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. From a worldly standpoint he had the best of everything. Taught the knowledge of the Egyptians, and having the best of all that Egypt had to offer, many would say that it would be crazy to give all of that up. He
