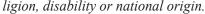
4-H Summer Camp

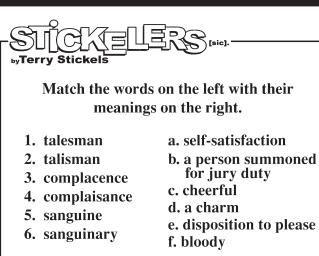
