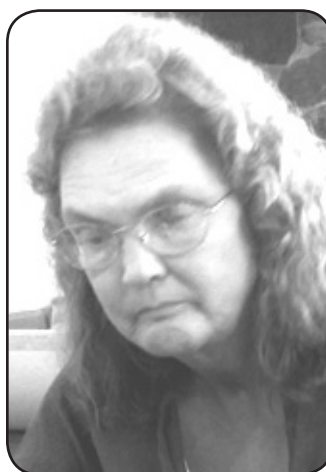
## Darlene Jones, 46

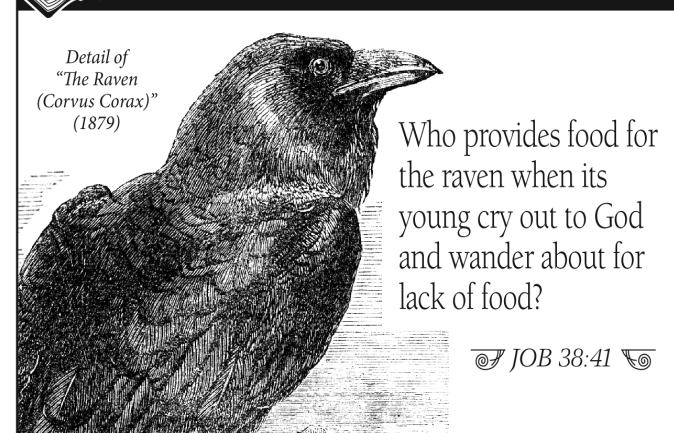
