There is no doubt that by now all of us have been exposed to the rhetoric that is being telecast all over our nation by those who are seeking political positions, locally, state, and federal. I suppose that many of these are good people seeking these jobs purely out of a good conscience, hoping to make a difference for good among those who they hope to serve. 
The answer can be yes, if men will change and turn back to God and obey His word!
