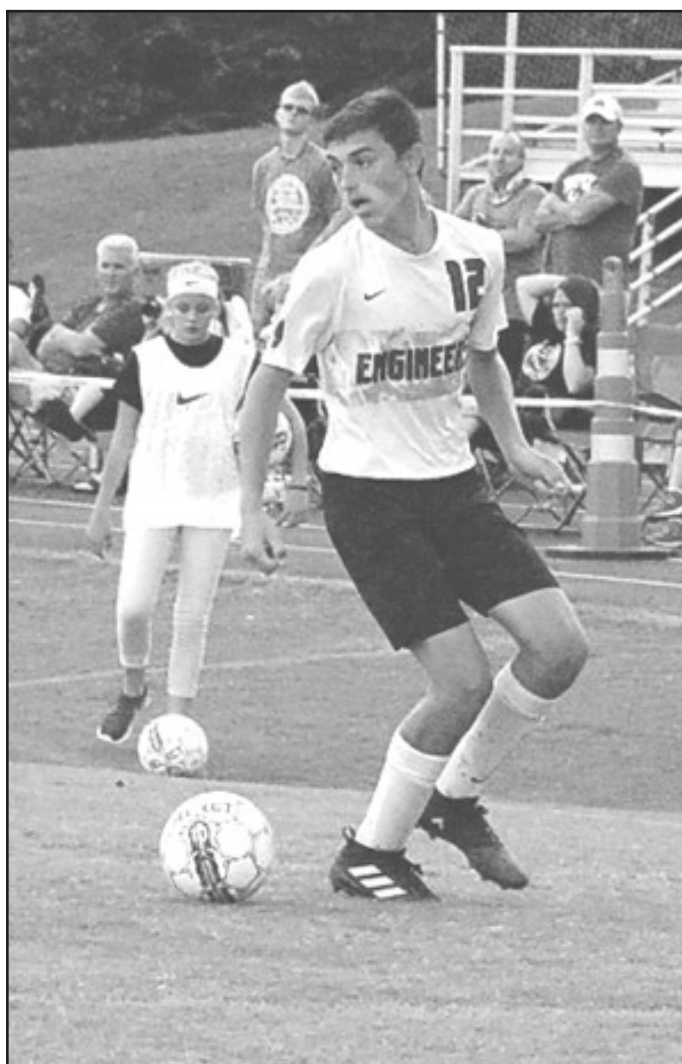
The Estill County Engineers Football team continues to look for their second win of the season after dropping a 41-30 decision to Powell County last Friday

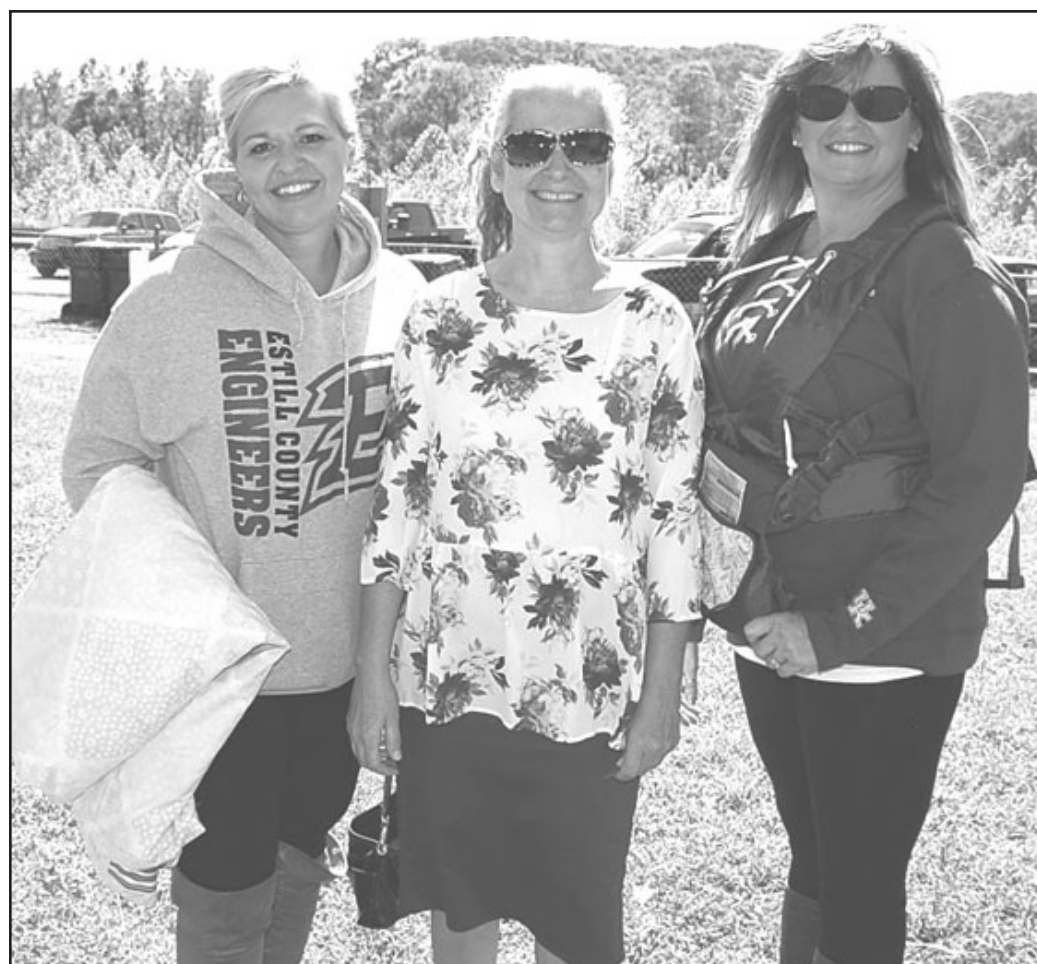
