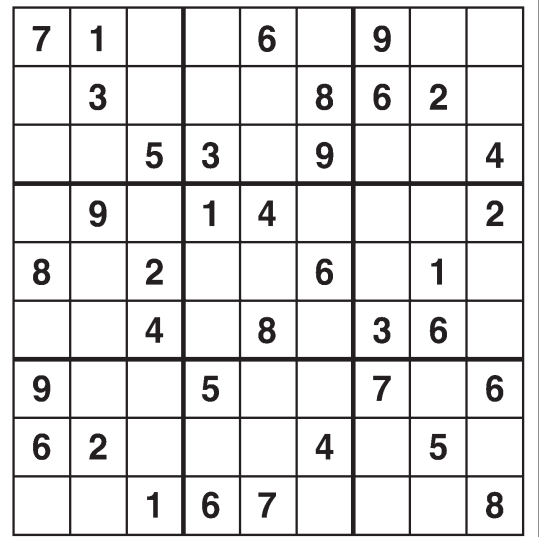
**RIDDLE SEARCH - LET'S EAT**
