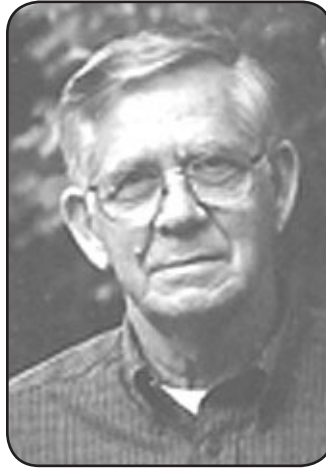
William D. Steele, 84
