

Band takes Reserve Grand Champion at Madison Southern

competing in class AA with Estill. After a solid performance in prelims, the band placed 2nd in class AA (less than 3 points behind Adair), and earned a finals spot for the evening competition.

The Marching Engineers turned in a much better performance in finals, improving their score by nearly 7 points, and outscoring all but one band. This overall 2nd place finish earned the band the

Reserve Grand Champion title out of all 16 participating bands! The Marching Engineers will be traveling to Pulaski County High School this week to compete in their 3rd regular season competition.

Engineers Drop Homecoming Game to Bath Co., 32-30

The Estill County Engineers Football Team saw their season record drop to 1-4 after allowing an eighteen point second half lead slip away in their 2017 Homecoming game. Bath County would score twenty fourth quarter points to steal the win away from the Engineers.

Bath County would control much of the first half while taking a 12-0 early lead as Estill's offense could not find a rhythm. J. O'Hair would finally get Estill on the board as he found the end zone on a keeper with a minute left before half time. A successful two point conversion would cut Bath's lead to four points. A beautifully executed pooch kick would be recovered by the Engineers giving them another opportunity to put points on the board. A 13 yard TD pass from O'Hair to T. Walker and another two point conversion would give Estill the lead 16-12 at the half.

The second half would see Estill gain control of the game as they would put

up fourteen unanswered points to take a 30-12 lead into the fourth quarter. Bath County would take to the air in the last stanza and a TD pass with just under seven minutes left would cut the Engineers lead to twelve points. An Estill turnover would result in six more for the Bobcats and when Estill could not recover the onside kick, Bath County would add a final touchdown plus two point conversion with two minutes left to seal or should I say, steal the win from Estill.
