USDA **Hardiness** 

This well-known resource for gardeners (online at http://www.usna.usda.gov/Hardzone/ushzmap.html) displays the average lowest temperatures for all areas of the U.S. A plant's tag should give its "hardiness" (the lowest temperatures the plant can withstand) and usually refers to this map to do so. An example would be: Green Mountain Boxwood: hardy to Zones 5-9.
