oning is to come upon all of this world covering all days of its existence.

some would not seem so terrible, but the thought of a personal Judgment grabs their attention.

in **2 Corinthians 5:10.** And it says, "For we must all *appear*;" so death is not the end in itself. Where will we appear after the resurrection? "Before the judgment seat of Christ . . ." **Romans 14:12** says, "So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God." 1 is ready to judge the quick and the dead." Even now eternal judgment is made ready, so only the hand of God will determine the day or hour. Not only will hated the false way. this day be a day of accounting, it will also be a day of reception. Again, the purpose of this Judgment is to be determined as a <u>day of retribution</u>, for our study text says, "that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it *be good or bad.*" So, while we are living there on earth, remember that all the things that we may do, or say, will be remembered when we stand before Jesus.
