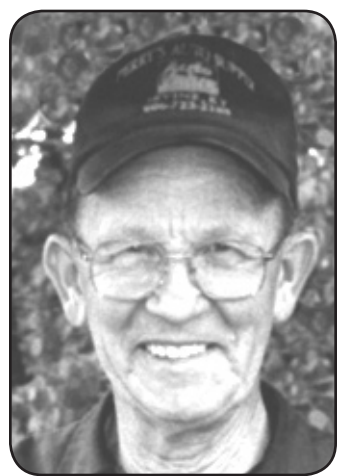
Clayton Angel, 77

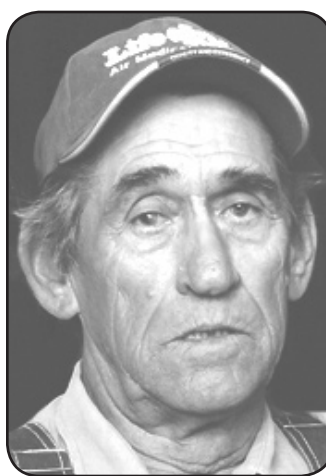
Charles Ova Burton, 77
