## University of Kentucky Has Record Dean's List

LEXINGTON, Ky. (Jan. 15, 2019)—A record number of students made the University of Kentucky Dean's List for the fall 2018 semester, including seven from Estill County. The 7,412 students were recognized for their outstanding academic performance. The previous record was reached in fall 2016.

To make a Dean's List in one of the UK colleges, a student must earn a grade point average of 3.6 or higher and must have earned 12 credits or more in that semester, excluding credits earned in pass-fail classes. Some UK colleges require a 3.5 GPA to make the Dean's List.
