## KSP, IPD, and Estill County Sheriff Activity Reports

**Brandon Michael Gillespie**, 20, of Winchester Road, Irvine was arrested November 4 by Trooper C. Caudill. He was charged with being a fugitive from Hamilton County, Ohio.

He is awaiting extradition in Three Forks Regional Jail. He was charged in Hamilton County with possession of drugs.

IPD Officer Jason Conrad served a warrant on **Calvin Jones**, 47, of Crooked Creek Road, Irvine on November 4 from Estill District Court.

The warrant says Jones failed to appear for an arraignment on seven traffic related charges. No bond was set.

**Matthew Knopp**, 31, of Millers Creek Road, Ravenna was served November 9 by Officer Stewart Morris with a warrant from Estill Circuit Court for failure to appear.

Knopp was found guilty in 2016 of two counts of criminal possession of a forged instrument, second degree. Twenty-eight charges of criminal possession of a forged instrument, second degree were dismissed. No bail was set.

Knopp was also served with a bench warrant from Laurel District Court on Nov. 9 by Officer Morris.

This warrant says that Knopp is in arrears of \$19,081.07 in child support. His bond was set at \$10,000 cash.

**Jacob Henry**, 24, of Hardy Road, Irvine was served November 10th with an Estill District Court bench warrant by Chief Brad Smith.

Henry allegedly failed to appear. He had been found

guilty in July of public intoxication, second degree disorderly conduct, resisting arrest, and second degree criminal mischief.

Barrett was given diversion on February 7 for a charge of trafficking in a controlled substance, first offense and first degree.

He came in contact with Sparks at his home. He said Sparks was outside arguing with his parents and was also being belligerent to his stepdad.

The council discussed contacting the Kentucky League of Cities to find out what needed to be done in order to make the payroll ordinance legal. Mayor Tipton said she would also contact the city's attorney to see what needed to be done to correct the situation.

The county will be paid \$211,289.36; Estill County Schools, \$1,211,204.48; Estill County Health Dept., \$188,697.53; Estill County Extension Service, 169,706.11; the ambulance service, \$216,932; the library, \$317,786.41; soil conservation, \$34,112.44; fire protection, \$1,875.00; and watershed, \$3,336.82. (Not all property owners pay the fire protection or watershed tax.)
