Laurel Wilt Disease: A Threat

to Kentucky Sassafras Trees

detected in southwestern Kentucky. This disease,

which is transmitted by the redbay ambrosia beetle, has the potential to rapidly kill sassafras trees.

Symptoms include sudden wilt and rapid death

with dead red-brown leaves still attached. Death can occur within weeks to months after infec-

tion. Sapwood may exhibit a dark, streaky staining

when bark is cut away. Currently no management

options are available for this disease. However, it

is important to avoid movement of infected plants

or dead wood to prevent spread of the disease. As

this disease is new to Kentucky, efforts are ongo-

ing to determine the extent to which it is present in


