Working on the Assignment That God has given us

Why does anyone decide to become a Gospel preacher? I can't speak for other men, but I believe that I can answer that for myself. After I obeyed the Gospel, I developed an intense desire to know more of its contents. So, when doing so, I, through study, began to build a fire within my heart to tell it to others. Especially when I read what my Lord said in **Matthew 5:16**, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." So, with this information and many more, I held by for a short time but finally relented and made my feeble attempt to preach. Surprisingly, I was well received and the Lord began to encourage my efforts. So, for forty-nine years, the fire still burns within me as it did back then.

Then, I read the admonition of the Apostle Paul found in **1 Corinthians 9:16-17**, "For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel! ¹⁷For if I do this thing willingly, I have a reward: but if against my will, a dispensation of the gospel is committed unto me."

So, when I began to make my attempt to preach, I began to see the importance of preaching by the responses that people were making toward it by repenting, being baptized for the remission of their sins. So, like my own, I saw others having their changed their lives as well.

Then I knew what Paul meant in **2 Corinthians 5:19-21**, "To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. ²⁰Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. ²¹For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

So, for all these years, my motivations are still the same; preach the Gospel, baptize the believer, and teach them how to faithfully worship the Lord. I am grateful unto the Lord for giving me this responsibility, for I have seen the results of it in many people.

In **2 Timothy 2:1-2**, Paul said to his young preacher son, "Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. ²And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also."

So, there it is, the Lord has given us a commission to go into the world and preach the Gospel. I have been blessed to preach in several locations and several states, but, at present, my part of the world is here in this local region and so we go. Personally, I don't see any complete retirement for this preacher.
